

Subject: IMCOM 140730-01 – 7th Mounted Warfare - Historic Vehicle Rally (24-26 OCT 2014)

Purpose: Request approval for privately owned historic military vehicles (wheeled and tracked and fixed wing aircraft) to conduct an event on Fort Hood military reservation tank trails and training areas on 24-26 OCT 2014.

Discussion:

1. There are numerous people living in the vicinity of Ft Hood, throughout the state of Texas and the surrounding states that have taken time and effort to restore historic military vehicles (WWII, Korean War, Vietnam, Desert Storm vintage). Because of the age of these vehicles and the slow speeds they attain, off-road activities are necessarily limited. The tank trails on Ft. Hood reservation provide an excellent venue to exercise these historic vehicles close to a paved road in case of breakdowns and recovery. The proposed event will utilize tank trails paralleling North Nolan Road, Old Georgetown Road, East and West Range Roads for access to pre-approved Training Areas over the weekend.
 - a. Active Duty training or movement will take priority over this event. Training Areas will be reserved through Range Control [*procedure verified with Mr Greg Simpson, Range Control (254-553-1943 and Mr. Mitchell Sheppard, Range Scheduling (254-287-3616)*].
 - b. Request approved vehicles and participants, from the community, to enter the installation through approved Access Control Points, 0600-2200 hours, 25-27 OCT 2013. Consolidated attendance list will be provided for vetting and approval to alleviate the large crowds at the Visitor's Center [*Procedure verified with Ms. Betty Allen, DES Access Control Operations (254-287-4570)*].
 - c. Anti-terrorism Event Planning Worksheet v5.2 (See Attachment 1. AT Event Planning Worksheet v5.2) will be processed IAW Force Protection procedures [*Procedure verified with Mr. Victor Hage (254-288-4639) & Mr. Ron Stamper (254-286-5377), Security and Intelligence Division, III Corps*].
 - d. For movement in the requested Training Areas, all vehicles and personnel will be registered with the Area Access Registration form (See Attachment 2. FHT Form 210-9-1) with the Sportsman Center for Area Access Permit (See Attachment 2a. FHT Form 210-X9-3) and Vehicle Area Permit (See Attachment 2b. FHT Form 210-X9-2). Alternate form of permit will be a memorandum from the Sportsman Center manager with a consolidated list of participants carried by the convoy commander [*Procedure verified with Ms. Judy Johnson, Manager, Sportsman Center (254-532-4552)*].
 - e. Request permission for approved tracked vehicles to travel on Fort Hood asphalt roads. Approval will be by individual vehicle, pre-vetted and approved by DPW Traffic Engineer [*Procedure verified with (Mr. Travis R. Clark), DPW-Traffic Engineer (254-287-3055)*].
 - f. Arrangements for event camping at Belton Lake Outdoor Recreation Area Office (BLORA) will be made through the BLORA office. Participating tracked vehicles will be transported to and downloaded only at pre-approved locations [*Location and reservation procedure verified with Ms. Brandi Crist, ODR Branch Manager/BLORA (254-287-3722)*].
 - g. Personally Owned Weapons (POWs) will be registered by their owner at the Visitor Welcome Center prior to bringing any weapons onto the installation. All persons transporting firearms are subject to registration requirements and will carry Fort Hood Form 190-19. (See Attachment 3. FH Form 190-19). Replicas of weapons and inert (dummy) ordnance for displays are approved by PMO and do not require registration. There will be NO live or blank ammunition authorized at this event [*Procedure verified with MSG Catron Jones, PMO Operations NCOIC, Fort Hood (254-287-3613)*].

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- h. Request permission for over flight of Fort Hood training areas and landing privileges for vintage Army military fixed wing aircraft. (See Attachment 4a. Aircraft Operations Itinerary). Aircraft are not authorized over flight of impact area. Request permission for aircraft to land at Hood Army Airfield and Gray Army Airfield 24 to 26 October 2014 (exact times to be coordinated with Fort Hood – DAC Airfield Mgr, Robert Gray AAF & Hood AAF). In accordance with Army Regulation AR 95-2, Table 10-2 (Page 30), Category 8, the Civil Aircraft Landing Permit packet (See Attachment 4c-e. Civil Aircraft Landing Permit) for each civilian aircraft (See Attachment 4b. Aircraft Specifications) will be processed separately for Installation/Garrison Commander approval. Civil Aircraft Landing Permit packet will consist of DD Form 2400 - Certificate of Insurance; DD Form 2401 - Civil Aircraft Landing Permit; DD Form 2402 - Hold Harmless Agreement [Procedure verified with Mr. Tracy Crawford, DAC, Airfield Manager, Robert Gray AAF (254-287-5102); Mr. Al Koch, DAC, Airfield Manager, Hood AAF (254-288-3811); Mr. Robert Ulrigg, Air Traffic and Airspace Officer (254-288-1424)]. 1-227th ARB POC: 1LT Randal G. - i. Request use of the Army Community Service parking lot (corner Battalion Ave and T.J. Mills Rd) for 24 OCT 2014 vehicle static display [Coordination with SGM Edward Lewis, III Corps G3 Operations (254-287-7535)].
- j. III Corps “Certificate of Appreciation” for participants will be processed for Commanding General signature. [Procedure verified with SSG Bayyinah White, Office Services Assistant, MSE Admin (254-287-2012)].
- k. Expect 5 to 25 vehicles to attend event. Vehicles will be as close to 10-20 standards as possible for restored WWII/Korean/Vietnam/Desert-Storm war era equipment.
- l. Historic military motorcycles will be operated with appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (See Attachment 5. Motorcycle PPE) in compliance with CG Policy Letter Safety-02.
- m. Civilian off-road vehicles will not participate in this event. Participation will be limited to historic military wheeled and tracked vehicles restored to military configuration.
- n. Any movement on tank trails will be in convoy configuration. Vehicles will not travel on tank trails individually. Disabled vehicles will self-recover or will be towed / trailered as necessary.

2. All participants will attend event in compliance with Fort Hood regulations and policies (IAW Command Policy: SJA-02). Vehicles will only maneuver on approved Tank Trails and Training Areas (See Attachment 6. Area Strip Map). Final schedule and convoy routes TBD and Training Areas will be scheduled with Range Control. 3. This event will incur no cost to the government. Risk is considered XXXXX (See Attachment 7. Risk Assessment). All participants will sign a Release of Liability form (See Attachment 8. Release of Liability form) prior to any activities conducted on Fort Hood.
